

Gadsden City High School Beta Club Application for Membership

This chapter of the National Beta Club is governed by the academic and financial policies enumerated in the National constitution of the National Beta Club. The purpose of this organization is the promotion of scholarship, leadership, and good citizenship at Gadsden City High School.

Please read carefully the following by-laws:

1. The standards of membership must conform to the general features as stated in the National Constitution. These qualifications are (a) worthy character, (b) good mentality, (c) creditable achievement, and (d) commendable attitude. The standards and means for appraising these qualities shall be determined by the administration of Gadsden City High School.
2. Scholastic requirements for membership are: 10th grade-90, 11th grade-88, and 12th grade-86 (Averages will be taken from 1st and 2nd semester core class averages from the previous school year).
3. The classes from which members may be drawn are 10th through 12th grades.
4. Loss of membership from the Beta Club:
A member may be dismissed from membership if:
 - a. his/her scholastic record falls below that required for his/her class. A probationary period of one semester will be given to allow the member with a scholastic deficit to raise his/her scholastic record above the minimum required for membership.
 - b. he/she does not participate in required meetings, service projects, and fund-raising projects (see attached agreement).
 - c. the executive head of Gadsden City High School, Mr. Jeff Colegrove, may drop a member from membership for moral or disciplinary reasons that are deemed by him to be sufficient.
5. Meetings: Mandatory monthly meetings will be held on the 2nd Tuesday of every month at 7:15 in the Bandroom.
6. Service Projects : As soon as possible, after its activation in the fall semester of the school year, this chapter of the National Beta Club will undertake a program of service each month, which will benefit Gadsden City High School and the community. These projects shall be decided upon only after consultation with and approval of the executive head of the high school (see attached agreement).
7. Membership fee: The membership fee for each student coming into the National Beta Club is \$25.00 for New Members and \$15.00 for Renewal Members (**due upon acceptance**). This amount defrays the cost of an official pin, certificate of membership, a membership card, a seal for the high school diploma upon graduation, subscription to the *Beta Club Journal* for the time that the member is in high school and a club t-shirt. There can be no refund of membership fees after the student is certified to membership. The standard membership fee is payable by each student regardless of the date of affiliation with the organization.
